



Recommended germination method

Place the seeds on a base of cellulose paper (kitchen paper) moistened with distilled water at room temperature inside a Tupperware-type container.




Then, cover them with another layer of moist paper and close the container.

(The paper should be moist, but not soaked)



Put the container in a dark place with a constant temperature.

It's important that the seeds are not subjected to temperature changes.



Open the container a couple of minutes a day to air it out and check if they have germinated.


If the paper has dried out, moisten it a bit more.





As soon as they have germinated, transfer them to the substrate (this can take from one to seven days).





When the seeds have three tiers of leaves,
we can move them outdoors.

IMPORTANT!

Do not germinate directly in the soil.
Do not leave the seeds submerged in
water.
